## DESCRIPTION OF THE PROJECT

People around the world face violence and inequality—and sometimes torture, even execution—because of who they love, how they look, or who they are. Sexual orientation and gender identity are integral aspects of our selves and should never lead to discrimination or abuse. We are seeing facing abuses based on sexual orientation and gender identity worldwide, including torture, killing and executions, arrests under unjust laws, unequal treatment, censorship, medical abuses, discrimination in health and jobs and housing, domestic violence, abuses against children, and denial of family rights and recognition. This also leads that LGBTQ community hide their private lives from colleagues and clients for fear of homophobia, exclusion or in case they are overlooked for valuable promotions. Sexual orientation and gender identity may be seen as a barrier to promotion or recognition of achievements. In some cases LGBTQ people avoid certain careers where they think they will experience hate.

We want to motivate the young people to be activists about the issues in their societies that they want to change. By attending this youth exchange the youth from the participating countries will gain new skills about using film and storytelling as a way of activism which they could use in the future. The other issue we want to address is youth unemployment - with this project we want to promote photography and film as skills that any youngster can acquire and that can lead to finding a job in this creative field. We want to use film as a tool for youth activism and to provide our participants with this tool for their voices to be heard all over Europe. During the working days of the project, the team from 5 different countries will create short films on the topics of LGBTQ inclusion, hate speech, discrimination and human rights that will be screened the last day. The main AIM of this project is to use film to raise the awareness of the existence of LGBTQ people, to overcome hate-speech and to accept and include LGBTQ persons in society and to promote the use of storytelling and short films as tools for activism.





## VENUE OF THE PROJECT

The project will take place in Zebegény, Hungary, at Szőnyi Tábo, which is a lovely place that hosts art projects all the time. (<http://szonyitabor.hu/>)

At the northern border of the country, Zebegény lies in the most poetic corner of the valley of the Danube. From the picturesque village you can easily reach many historical settlements (Visegrád, Szentendre, Vác, Esztergom). Zebegény itself offers prestigious attractions. The famous church of Kós, the István Szőnyi Memorial Museum, the home and studio of the painter, the National Historical Collection, the National Flag and the Heroic Monument built by Géza Maróti, combines the great natural environment that combines the advantages of the mountains and the waterfront.



The participants will be accommodated in bungalows for six people. We will provide 3 meals per day served at the venue. **Please make sure that each participant fill out the application form** (link <https://goo.gl/forms/Oyt0BMCr5E8joHe2>) so we know the dietary requirements of the participants.

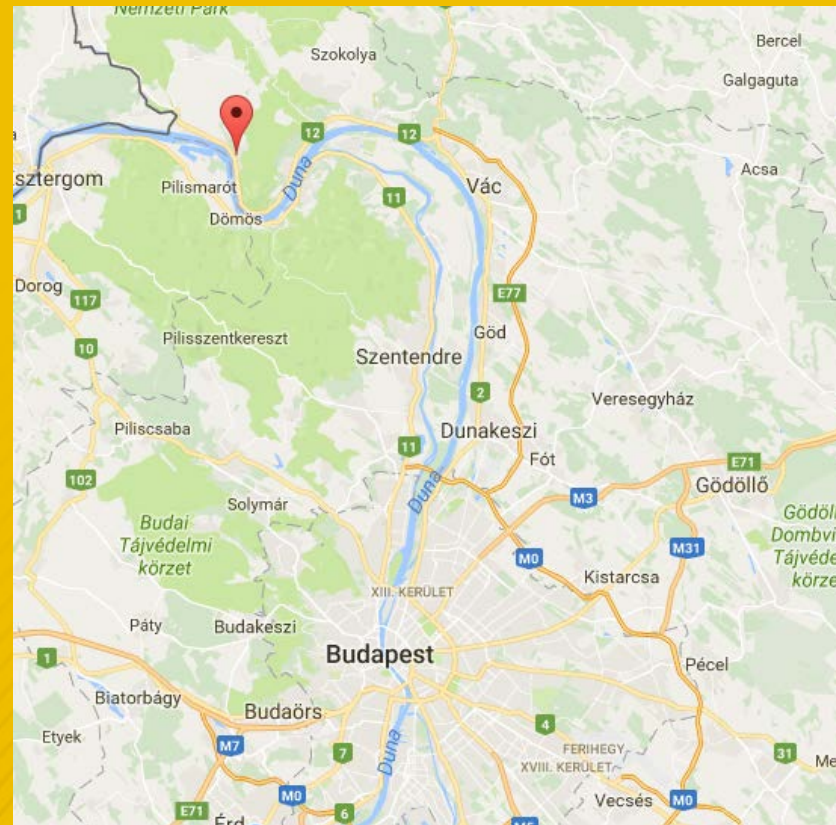

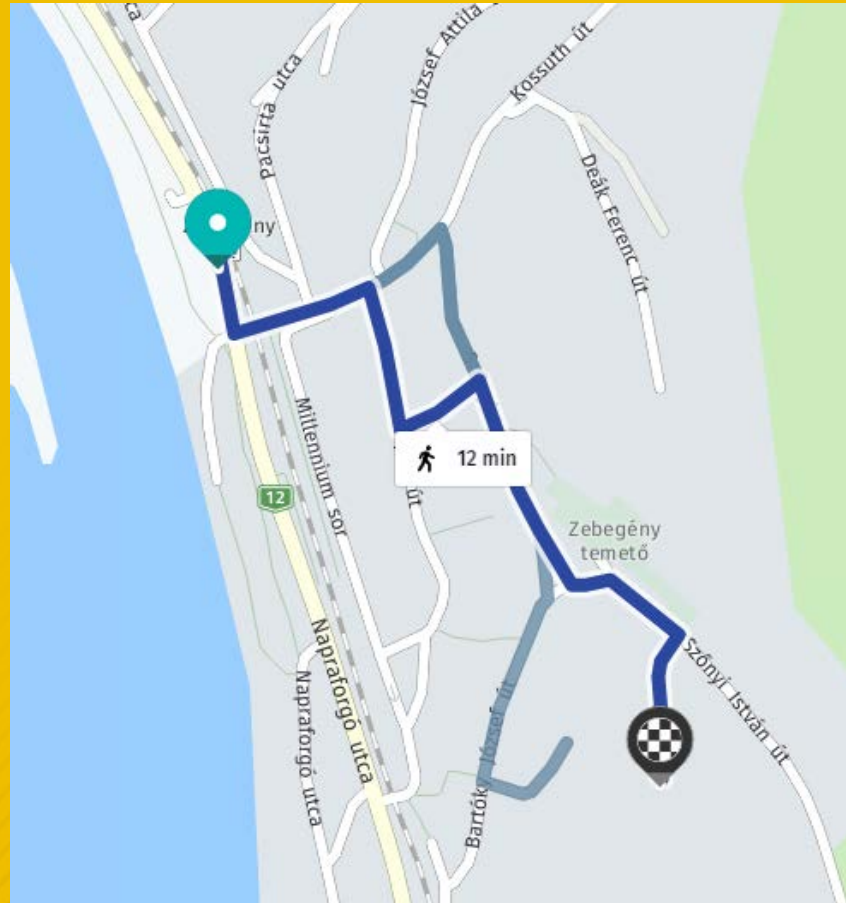
